Rules & Regulations

General Rules:

- 1. Strict silence, decorum and discipline must be maintained in the library. Use of cell-phones with in the library premises is strictly not allowed.
- 2. Smoking, eating, sleeping and talking loudly are strictly prohibited in the library.
- 3. Personal belonging like bags (laptop, shoulder, sling), umbrellas, etc. should be deposited at the Property Counter. These are not allowed inside the Library.
- 4. Readers are advised not to leave their valuable items like money, mobile debit card, credit card etc. at the Property Counter.
- 5. The Library shall not be responsible for any loss or damage of the personal belongings of the users.
- 6. Documents taken out of the shelves must be left on the table. Replacing the books on shelves is not encouraged as it may get misplaced.
- 7. Readers should not mark, underline, write, tear pages or otherwise damage the library documents.
- 8. Newspapers, magazines, and journals must be read only in the library on specific tables and should not be taken to any other reading areas.
- 9. No library material can be taken out of the library without permission. Unauthorized removal of anything belonging to the library will be treated as theft and dealt accordingly.
- 10. A non-member can use the library material on the premises with the permission of the Assistant Librarian.
- 11. Library clearance may have issued only after depositing valid library card, if the card is issued earlier to the member.
- 12. Anyone who violates the rules and regulations of the library would be liable to lose the privilege of library membership and may be debarred from using the library facilities.
- 13. Every Student will be issue 2 books for 15 days.
- 14. If the book is not returned on the due date, then a fine of Rs. 1/- per day will be charged for 1st 15 days of delay, then Rs. 2/- per day for the next 15 days of delay. If the student fails to return the book even after 30 days, then he / she will have imposed a further fine of Rs. 5/- per day from the 31 days onward.
- 15. In case the book is damaged or lost, then the student will be required to buy the latest edition of the book or to pay the original cost of the book.
