### **B.A.** Honours in SANSKRIT

There will be six semesters in the three- year B.A. Honours in SANSKRIT. The Curriculum consists of 14 Core Courses (C), 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), 2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and 4 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses and 4 Generic Elective (GE) courses [to be taken from the pool of Generic Elective courses OTHER THAN SANSKRIT]. Each course is of 50 marks. L stands for Lecture Hour, T for Tutorial Hour and P for Practical Hour.

- 60% of Questions are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanāgarī script in 1<sup>st</sup> Year (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semesters).
- 80% of Questions are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanāgarī script in 2<sup>nd</sup> Year (3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semesters).
- 100% of Questions are to be answered compulsorily in Sanskrit with Devanāgarī script in 3<sup>rd</sup> Year (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Semesters).

Apart from these, 2 Generic Elective courses (GE) [to be taken from the pool of Generic Elective courses, EXCEPT THOSE IN SANSKRIT], 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC-Elective), 4 Skill Enhancement courses (SEC) (from the program in the subject selected by the candidate) and 2 Discipline Specific Elective courses (DSE) from Discipline-1 and 2 such courses from Discipline-2 are to be taken.
